Bonds are expected to be sold through a negotiated offering and/or private placement.

Proceeds will be used to finance the design, construction and/or rehabilitation costs relating to residential facilities located on various State University of New York campuses, to refund all or a portion of the DASNY SUNY Dorm Program Series 2015A and Series 2015B bonds, and to undertake a tender of all or a portion of various DASNY SUNY Dorm Program bonds, including the stax-exempt Series 2017A, 2018A and 2019A bonds, as well as the taxable Series 2019B and 2021A bonds for debt service savings. Bond proceeds would be used to pay the purchase price of bonds accepted for tender.
