The incumbent will serve as a member of the Health Unit. The Health Unit oversees: the Medicaid Managed Care, Medicaid Managed Long-Term Care, Nursing Homes, New York State of Health Exchange, aspects of the Affordable Care Act, Minimum Wage, Supportive Housing, Home and Community Based Long-Term Care; the Medicaid State Global Cap, Federal Medicaid Spending, other State Agency Medicaid spending; non-Medicaid components of the Department of Health (DOH), the State Office of the Aging (SOFA) and the Office of the Medicaid Inspector General (OMIG) budgets and assists in budget Development and coordination, appropriations, and various other assignments involving different aspects of health care finance.

Responsibilities of the Budget and Data Analyst in the Health Unit would include, but are not limited to:

- Interpret data, analyze results using statistical techniques and provide ongoing reports.
- Perform data extraction, aggregation, and quality checks from multiple sources and tables in support of trend identification and root cause analysis.
- Create visual and written data communications to present relevant findings and materials to upper level-management and outside stakeholders.
- Assess the content of current data systems to ensure they support the analytic needs of assignments and make informed recommendations to management.
- Work with management to prioritize information needs.
- Develop and implement databases, data collection systems, data analytics and other strategies that optimize statistical efficiency and quality.
- Locate, define, and recommend new process improvement opportunities.
- Work with other Data Analysts, Budget Examiners, and management to develop and build analytic models in support of policy development and budgetary proposals.
- Evaluating and participating in the development of programmatic and policy solutions aimed at addressing care and financing needs for vulnerable populations within the State;
- Working with staff from the Governor's Office, the Legislature, the Department of Health and other Units within DOB.

Qualification/Skills:

- Technical expertise regarding data models, database design development, data mining and segmentation techniques.
- Strong analytical skills with the ability to collect, organize, analyze, and disseminate significant amounts of information with attention to detail and accuracy.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
- Knowledge of statistics and experience using statistical packages for analyzing datasets (Excel, SPSS, SAS, Salient, Tableau, etc.).
