## 2006-07 Executive Budget 30-Day Amendments

## Amendments to Senate 6456, Assembly 9556 (Public Protection and General Government Article VII)

Part B, relating to aid and incentives for municipalities is amended to:

• Add language to authorize the Department of State to contract with the Government Law Center at Albany Law School to provide regional technical assistance through academic institutions relating to consolidations, mergers, dissolutions, cooperative agreements and shared services.

Part C, relating to local government procurement practices is amended to:

 Add language requiring municipalities to conform to current State procurement standards when "piggybacking" on out of state contracts.

Part G, relating to a temporary retirement incentive for certain public employees, is amended to:

 Delete language which imposes certain penalties on Tier 3 and 4 employees under age 55 with 30 or more years of service and make technical corrections.

Part H, relating to providing for the administration of certain funds and authorizing the State Comptroller to deposit funds to accounts, is amended to:

- Increase the transfer amount from the miscellaneous operating grants fund (290) to the special revenue fund (339), tri-state federal regional planning account (17).
- Include appropriations from the miscellaneous capital projects fund to be in accordance with section 93 of the State Finance Law.
- Add reimbursement authorization for increased appropriation amounts for economic development.

Part S, relating to release on parole, conditional release and presumptive
release is amended to:

• Mandate that any individual released from a local correctional facility by a local conditional release commission, or by the Division of Parole, remain under parole supervision for one year from the date of their release.
