Weighted pupils for the purposes of this paragraph shall mean the sum of the attendance of students in grades ten through twelve in career education sequences in trade, industrial, technical, agricultural or health programs plus the product of sixteen hundredths multiplied by the attendance of students in grades ten through twelve in career education sequences in business and marketing as defined by the commissioner in regulations. The career education aid ratio shall be computed by subtracting from one the product obtained by multiplying fifty-nine percent by the combined wealth ratio. This aid ratio shall be expressed as a decimal carried to three places without rounding, but not less than thirty-six percent." and insert</p> <p>"Section 3602 of the education law is amended by adding a new paragraph d to subdivision 10 to read as follows:</p> <p><u>d. Aid for academic improvement. There shall be apportioned to such city school districts and other school districts which were not components of a board of cooperative educational services in the base year, an amount per pupil for each pupil eligible for aid pursuant to paragraph b of this subdivision to be computed by multiplying the career education aid ratio computed pursuant to such paragraph b of this subdivision by the sum of (1) one hundred dollars plus (2) the quotient of one thousand dollars divided by the lesser of one or the combined wealth ratio. Aid for academic improvement shall be unrestricted general aid available to support any academic programs of the school district."</u></p>

The local share ceiling amount for claims for services provided in the two thousand eight--two thousand nine school year shall be determined based on approved claims filed with the commissioner for state reimbursement as of April first, two thousand nine and shall equal the product of: (A) an inflation factor equal to one hundred seven and five-tenths percent, and (B) the municipality's local share base, as adjusted.
