In addition to any payment made by a public benefit corporation pursuant to an assessment imposed under sections 2975, 2975-a, 2976 and 2976-a of the public authorities law, a public benefit corporation is authorized to make voluntary contributions to the state general fund for any lawful purpose at any time from any public benefit corporation funds in such amounts as deemed to be feasible and advisable by such public benefit corporation's governing board after due consideration of the public benefit corporation's legal and financial obligations. Notwithstanding any other law, the payment of a voluntary payment pursuant to this subdivision is deemed to be a valid and proper purpose for which available funds may be applied. Voluntary contributions made to the state pursuant to this subdivision shall be payable to the state treasury to the credit of the general fund." and insert "§ 18. \$2,500,000 from the general fund to the miscellaneous special revenue fund, tribal state compact revenue account (22169). Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, such funds may be advanced to a municipality located within the county of Cattaraugus hosting a gaming facility pursuant to the requirements of an appropriation contained in chapter 53 of the laws of 2012; provided, however, that any such advance shall reduce the amount otherwise due to such municipality by an equivalent amount, and that, upon receipt of any funds in the tribal state compact revenue account pursuant to a tribal state compact, such funds shall first be used to reimburse any transfer from the general fund pursuant to this section."
