

AID TO LOCALITIES BUDGET BILL
(Senate 6353-A and Assembly 8553-A)

Office of Prekindergarten Through Grade Twelve Education Program

The amendments:

- Clarify that higher education partners participating in an early college high schools program to set a reduced rate of tuition and/or fees, or to waive tuition and/or fees entirely, for students participating in such early college high schools program; and
- Clarify that higher education partners participating in a P-TECH program to set a reduced rate of tuition and/or fees, or to waive tuition and/or fees entirely, for students participating in such P-TECH program.
