**DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION**

**MISCELLANEOUS -- ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES****NEW YORK STATE SPECIAL INFRASTRUCTURE ACCOUNT**New York State Special Infrastructure Account (CCP)

The amendments:

- Provide \$500,000 planning grants to ten cities and/or not-for-profits serving the ten cities with high poverty rates in the State and access to a \$20 million grant pool to match private sector and foundation funding. The original language restricted the \$25 million to hunger prevention and nutrition assistance grants; and
- Make a technical correction to remove unnecessary language from the Municipal Restructuring Fund related to an anti-poverty initiative.
