Dear Governor Spitzer:

I am writing on behalf of the Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester and the 800 members we represent, including cultural organizations, educational institutions, and artists from a broad range of creative disciplines.

I strongly encourage you to include the requested funding increase for the New York State Council on the Arts, \$51.5 million (8.4% over 2007-2008), in your 2008 Budget.

As you know, the arts play a vital role in education, public safety, and economic development throughout New York State. In fact, Americans for the Arts has recently released a national economic impact study, which provides concrete evidence that the nonprofit cultural industry is a strong contributor to economic development.

In Monroe County alone, nonprofit cultural organizations and their audiences generate nearly \$200 million each year in economic activity, supporting over 6,000 full-time equivalent jobs. Even more importantly, the <u>study</u> documents that each dollar invested in a nonprofit cultural corporation generates a return on investment for local and state government as well as local business.

I strongly encourage you to include in your budget the investment in the arts represented by increased funding for the New York State Council on the Arts.
